Christmas in July



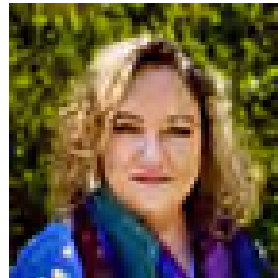
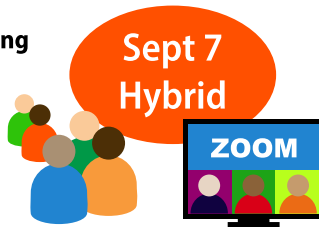
Once again, Kim promises a terrific program that has become one of our favorite events. This will be a hybrid event after our general meeting and include two projects for members to create.

September 7th, after general meeting Hybrid class

Amy Snell, (AKA The Devious Knitter), **designer, instructor, and collector of yarn, will be here in person.**



Amy will present her 3 hour program, *New Directions in Log Cabin Knitting* in-person and on Zoom. The class fee is \$ 45.00 and can be paid by PayPal or check. If, check, please mail to Sandra or bring to July meeting. Cash can also be accepted at the July meeting. Please bring the exact amount.

The concept of Log Cabin knitting is straightforward — modular knitting that can grow in all directions — but the execution can range from the simple to the complex. We'll review the best practices in the Log Cabin design, including different ways to pick up stitches for varying edge effects, then use those skills to dive into fun new constructions and use the basic building blocks to jump off into fun constructions that are limited only by your imagination!

Participants will need worsted weight yarn in various colors and appropriate sized needles.

The Hemet guild will have Amy for two, in-person demonstrations: the Latvian Braid and Helio Circles on September 6th. We have been invited to attend.

Lunch will be included in the cost if you sign up for both classes. The location will be at the Londonshire Mobile Home Park community center. More information will come.

Storing your winter knits.

Bugs love your beautiful fibers as much as you do. Bugs are attracted to surface body oils and perfumes as well as the fibers themselves. For best storage, wash your items before storing in air tight bags. Scented sachets can also be included in the bags as natural repellents.

"Anti-Bug" favor bags

1 Tsp. Thyme
1 Tsp. Rosemary
1 Whole clove
1 Peppermint leaf
